LOCATION	Situated in a 17 th -century palace just minutes from the center of Venice, the Dei Dogi occupies an exclusive spot overlooking the Lagoon and close to the Rialto. An ideal launching point for anyone visiting the city for the first time, the hotel is close to the city's Jewish Quarter, the Shakespearian Palazzo and the Ponte delle Guglie, and 15 minutes by water taxi from St. Mark's square.

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DESCRIPTION

A cornerstone in a city that is as mobile as a wave, the Dei Dogi is located in the prestigious Palazzo Rizzo Patarol, an aristocratic and palatial building that previously served as a French and Savoy embassy, as well as a monks' monastery. The Dei Dogi's story is deeply rooted in Venice's history and land, with its foundations in the area of the Madonna dell'Orto, at one time the only portion of the city to be cultivated. As such, today it is the only hotel in Venice with a historical garden: more than 2,000 square meters of greenery that has been splendidly preserved to create unique parkland amidst the narrow alleys of the city.

The Dei Dogi palace was one of the first examples of *Ca' veneziana* architecture, which became typical in the 18th century. The hotel's grand lobby is characterized by colorful marble, stucco work, silk and velvet tapestries, mirrors, Murano chandeliers, and a state-of-the-art meeting room. Time stands still in the soaring ceilings and period floors of bichrome stone, as well as the marble staircases which lead to the first floor and portraits of the doges of Venice in the corridor. A sumptuous but never ostentatious luxury imbues the hotel, its abundance of gold cleverly diluted by the lunar shades of the furnishings and walls. The overall effect is luxurious but never excessive, perhaps thanks to the measured and graceful rhythm of the monks who once lived there, or the history in the silk and velvet tapestries and 17th-century stucco work which has been perfectly restored.

GUEST ROOMS

The beauty of Venice unfolds in the Dei Dogi's guest rooms, as the silence of the surrounding garden makes the chaos of the nearby Rialto seem distant. The hotel has 68 guest rooms, including 16 Deluxe, 9 Junior Suites and a Presidential Suite. All rooms are finished with precious woods and brocades, and decked out with 17th-century carpets and glass features. Ancient decorations blend with modern comforts to assure guests feel quite at home in their rooms. The beds are antique gems, refinished with stylized flowers and leaves which reflect the wonderful garden atmosphere outside. The Presidential Suite overlooks the lagoon and the island of San Michele.

THE GARDEN

The enchantment of Venice as a lagoon city has long cast a spell over writers and artists, who have created memorable images of its profusion of charms. But in all those representations, one would be hard pressed to find a luxuriant garden atmosphere like that of the Dei Dogi. That's because the Dei Dogi is the only hotel in Venice with its own historical garden: a unique, 2,000 square meter space lush with luxuriant plants and blossoming flowers such as roses and hydrangea. A stroll amidst the garden's neoclassical layout reveals romantic 19th-century touches such as an ice house which was used to keep wine cool, a bridge and a grassy knoll, while the hushed tones beneath the greenery make the bustle of Venice seem far away indeed.



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DINING

Honored with a star by the Superior Institute of the Culinary Arts, the 80-seat **Giardino di Luca Restaurant** specializes in Venetian cuisine with international specialties created by the highly qualified chefs, together with a well-rounded selection of Italian wines. Whether dining in the restaurant by candlelight or in the garden on a cool spring evening, there is something to tempt every palate.

For cocktails and wine, the 18-seat **Bar Foscari Lounge** is a refined location for a Venetian treat, reminiscent of a cozy European bar. The intimate atmosphere is perfect for relaxing and conversing after working up a thirst visiting Venetian sites.
